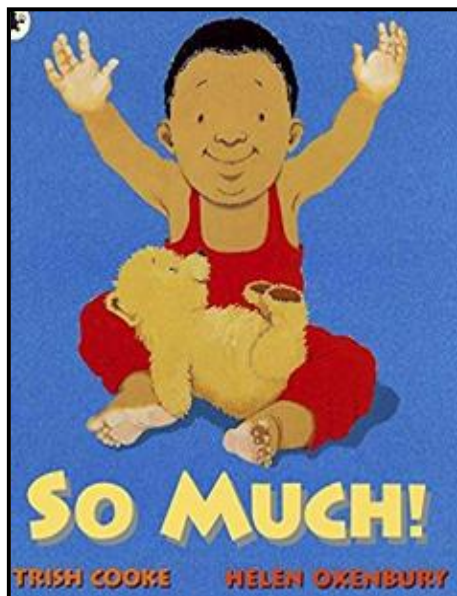


Autumn 1 Nursery Newsletter

A huge welcome to Nursery at South Rise!



This term we will be focussing on getting the children settled and introducing them to new routines. For example, leaving their adults at the start of the session and later taking part in group time. In Nursery, we want the children to become independent learners and therefore always encourage them to have a try; this may be to have a go at putting on their own jumper, apron etc.

Our first topic is 'All About Me'. We will be looking at what the children like to do and who is in their family. We will be looking at the books, Maisie's Birthday, You Choose and Handa's Surprise. It is a great way to get to know the children well and all their interests. We will of course be having many exciting learning opportunities including lots of cooking!

Tapestry

Tapestry is an online learning profile for each of your children. It will show you what your child has been learning at school. It also allows opportunity to take pictures at home and upload them for us to see. Everyone has been set up with an account, if you are struggling to access it then please let one of the team know and we can support you in getting up and running. Previously parents were allowed into the Nursery building but due to COVID19 this is no longer possible, so we ask that you regularly check tapestry for any information to be shared.

Notices

- We provide many exciting snacks for the children to have throughout their session at Nursery and we ask for 50p snack money per week. The money pot will be outside the main door on a Monday.
- On Wednesday 21st October, Nursery will be closed for AM and PM children (Full Time children can still attend). The day is to carry out parent meeting appointments. They will run all day and evening on Wednesday and then Thursday evening as well. We will inform you how these will take place nearer the time.
- When queuing to pick up or drop off, please keep 2 metres from each other and move along quickly to allow for safe drop off and pick up times.
- Please make sure your child comes in with a coat as the weather is getting colder and they spent lots of time outside.

Books and singing

We ask that every day you read a story with your child at home. You can look at the characters, get the children to create a story from the pictures and make predictions about what might happen next. Singing is so important in children's development, (whether you have a good voice or not!) it's a great thing to do at home together, the children are learning lots at Nursery so ask them to teach you!
